

ORDER FOR SERVICE BY PUBLICATION

It appearing to the Court from the allegations in the Petition for Temporary Legal Custody and Ex Parte Order, that ordinary service of process cannot be obtained. The Department has filed a Motion for Service by Publication and the Affidavit of Diligent Search that details personal attempts of service of process. The Department has indicated that the whereabouts of Respondent, Dora Elia Lopez Sanchez, Mother, is unknown and cannot be ascertained by diligent search, and therefore, the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon the Respondent.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that said Respondent be served by publication of the following notice once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in city of the last known address for the Respondent in Mexico.

It is further ORDERED that if the Respondent does not enter an appearance or otherwise answer the Petition, further personal service or service by further publication shall be dispensed with and service of any future notices, motions, orders or other legal documents in this matter may be made upon the Respondent by filing same with the Juvenile Court Clerk of Robertson County, Tennessee.

NOTICE TO DORA ELIA LOPEZ SANCHEZ, MOTHER


The State of Tennessee. Department of Children's Services, has filed a Petition alleging that the parent committed acts or failed to take actions that cause the child, **JAQUELINE ORTIZ-LOPEZ**, born March 3, 2004. to be Dependent and Neglected as defined by T.C.A. § 37-1-102 (b)(12) etc., and that disposition of the minor child should be with a 3rd party and/or State Custody. It appears that ordinary process of law cannot be served upon you because your whereabouts are unknown or you are avoiding service of process. You are hereby **ORDERED** to appear in the Juvenile Court of Robertson County, 529 South Brown Street, Springfield, TN 37172, on the 12 day of Dec, 2019 at 9:00 a.m., to personally answer the Petition. Failing to appear for the hearing on this date and time, without good cause, pursuant to the Rules of Juvenile Procedure and the Rules of Civil Procedure will result in the loss of your right to contest the Petition. You may view and obtain a copy of the State's Petition, and any other subsequently legal filings at the Robertson County Juvenile Court Clerk's Office, 529 South Brown Street, Springfield, TN 37172.
